**1. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

**CAUTION: Keep small parts away from children.**

**Strangulation Hazard:** Children can become entangled in cords. Power cords should be kept more than 1 metre away from the crib and baby's reach all the time. Baby monitors and cameras with power cords should never be hung on or near the crib. This product is not a toy and should be kept out of children's reach. This product contains small parts. Be careful not to lose them when opening and assembling the product.

**Read and keep instructions:** All safety and operating instructions must be read before the video baby monitor is used. This product cannot replace responsible adult supervision.

**Water and moisture:** This product is designed for indoor use only. The unit should not be exposed to rain, moisture, dripping or splashing. No objects filled with liquid should be placed on top of, or beside the product, such as a glass or vase. This item should not be used near water.

**DO NOT USE THE APPLIANCE:**

- If the cord or plug is damaged.
- If your baby monitor is not operating properly or has suffered any damage.

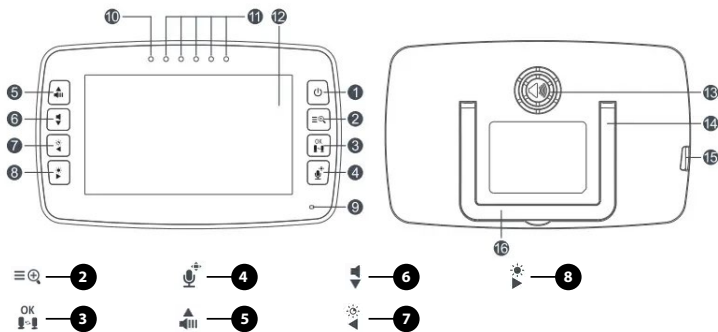

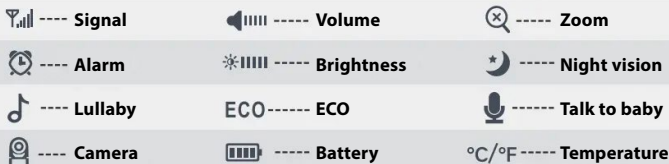


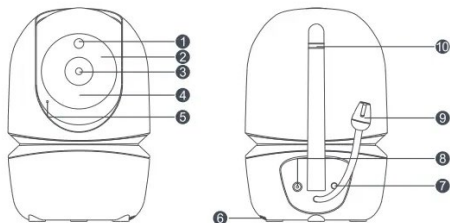

### 3. USING THE BABY MONITOR

#### CHARGING AND POWERING THE MONITOR UNIT

##### Step 1:

Charge the monitor by connecting the power adapter included in this package to the monitor and a socket. (It takes about 4 hours for the monitor to be fully charged).

##### Step 2:

Use the provided power adapter included in this package to connect the wall outlet with the baby unit.

##### Note:

- Place the camera at least 1m away from your child. Gently press and hold the power button for 3 seconds to turn on the monitor. Now you can see the image taken by the camera.
- Adjust the sound, brightness and reasonable positioning of the camera as you like.

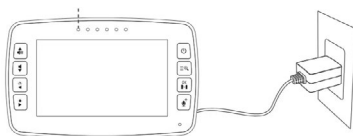
##### Tips:

To use the baby monitor, you must be able to establish a radio connection between the monitor and the camera. Distance may be affected by environmental conditions:

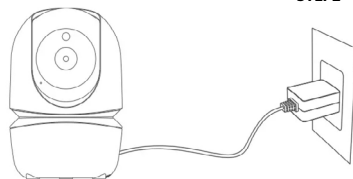
- Any large metal objects, such as a refrigerator, mirror, cabinet, metal doors or reinforced concrete between the child and the parent unit can block the radio signal. Signal strength can also be reduced by other solid structures, such as walls, or by radio or electrical equipment, such as TVs, computers, cordless or cell phones, fluorescent lights or dial switches, or even Wi-Fi systems.
- When using other 2.4 GHz products, such as wireless networks (Wi-Fi routers), Bluetooth systems or microwave ovens, interference may occur with this product, so keep the baby monitor at least 1,5 m away from these types of products.

## NIGHT VISION MODE

When the built-in photo sensor detects a low level of ambient light, the screen on the monitor unit will display in black and white the “**NIGHT VISION icon**” on the screen.

## PAN AND TILT

The camera unit can be remotely controlled from the monitor unit

**Step 1.** Press the “**PAN/TILT key**” and enter the Pan/Tilt mode.

**Step 2.** Press the “**UP key**” or “**DOWN key**” to tilt upward or downward.

**Step 3.** Press the “**LEFT key**” or “**RIGHT key**” to Pan left or right.

**Step 4.** Press the “**PAN/TILT key**” exit the Pan/Tilt mode.

**Note:** During the Pan/Tilt mode the navigation key can not be used to adjust volume and Brightness.

## TALK MODE

Press and hold the “**TALK TO BABY key**” on the monitor unit to talk to your baby through the camera unit’s loudspeaker. The “**TALK TO BABY icon**” will be displayed at the bottom right corner of the screen.

## DIGITAL ZOOM

**Step 1.** Press and hold the “**MENU/EXIT key**” for around 2 seconds enter Zoom mode.

**Step 2.** At the Zoom mode, press the “**PAN/TILT key**” to adjust the direction of the camera/image.

**Step 3.** Press the “**LEFT key**” to pan left; Press “**RIGHT key**” to pan right; Press “**UP key**” to tilt up; Press “**DOWN key**” to tilt down.

**Step 4.** Press and hold the “**MENU/EXIT key**” again around 2 seconds to operate Zoom out. During digital zoom mode the zoom icon will be displayed on the top of screen.

**Warm reminder:** If you want to adjust the Volume/Brightness you have to exit the Pan/Tilt (press Pan/Tilt key) mode before you operate it.

## SCAN AND SWITCH THE CAMERAS

Press “**OK key**” for 2 seconds to view the first camera, during the scan mode, the “**CAMERA icon**” will be displayed on the top of the scene. Each camera’s video will stay on the screen for around 10 seconds then change to the next camera. Short press the scan key again to switch the camera under the scan mode.

**Note:** This function is only available when two or more cameras are paired.

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## 4. MENU OPERATION

### LULLABY SETTING

You can soothe the baby to sleep by playing a gentle lullaby from the baby unit.

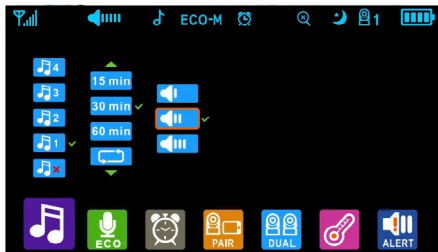
**Step 1:** Press “**MENU/EXIT key**” and the menu will display;

**Step 2:** Press the “**LEFT key**” or “**RIGHT key**” until the lullaby icon is highlighted;

**Step 3:** Press the “**UP key**” or “**DOWN key**” to select the lullaby you need;

**Step 3:** Press the “**UP key**” or “**DOWN key**” to select the Playback time and volume;

**Step 4:** Press “**OK key**” to confirm.



## ECO MODE SETTING

This mode allows you to control the audio activation of the baby monitor. When the ECO default setting is on, if there is no sound around the camera within 30 seconds, the baby unit will stop transmitting. The monitor screen turns off when the camera is not transmitting. When the camera detects that the sound is louder than the pre-set sensitivity level, it will start transmitting the signal again. To change the sensitivity level:

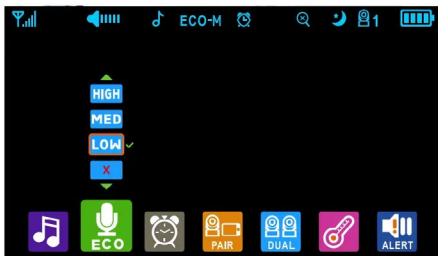
**Step 1:** Press “MENU/EXIT key” and the menu will display;

**Step 2:** Press the “LEFT key” or “RIGHT key” until the ECO icon is highlighted;

**Step 3:** Press the “UP key” or “DOWN key” to select the desire level;

**Step 4:** Press “OK key” to confirm.

**Note:** “LOW” High volume of sound is required to reactivate the transmission; “MED” Medium volume of sound is required to reactivate the transmission; “HIGH” Low volume of sound is required to reactivate the transmission; “X” No standby mode.



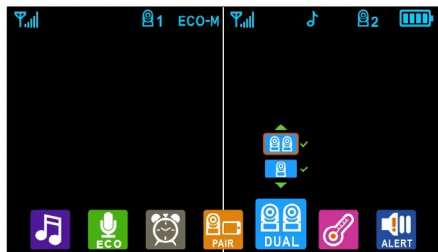
## DUAL VIEW SETTING

**Step 1:** Press “MENU/EXIT key” and the menu will display;

**Step 2:** Press the “LEFT key” or “RIGHT key” until the DUAL icon is highlighted;

**Step 3:** Press the “UP key” or “DOWN key” to select the single or dual view display;

**Step 4:** Press the “OK key” to confirm.



## PAIRING THE CAMERA AND MONITOR

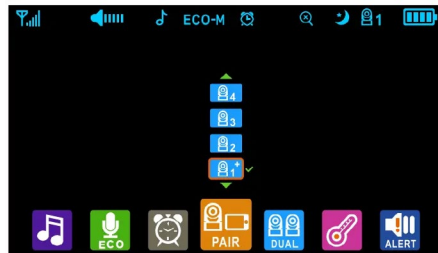
**Step 1:** Press “MENU/EXIT key” and the menu will display;

**Step 2:** Press the “LEFT key” or “RIGHT key” until the “PAIR icon” is highlighted, then press the “UP key” or “DOWN key” to select the baby unit to pair;

**Step 3:** Press the “OK key” to start the pairing;

**Step 4:** While the LED is flashing, press and hold the PAIR button on the back of the baby unit, once paired, the screen will display the image from the baby unit;

**Step 5:** If failed, please repeat the steps above.



## FEEDING TIMER SETTING

You can use the alarm to remind yourself to feed baby/change diapers/sleep, etc.

**Step 1:** Press “MENU/EXIT key” and the menu will display;

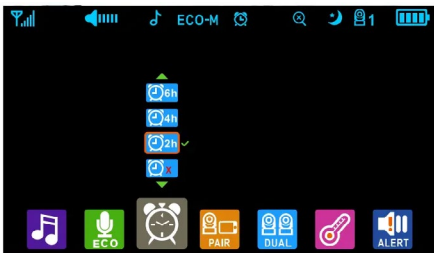
**Step 2:** Press the “LEFT key” or “RIGHT key” until the alarm icon is highlighted;

**Step 3:** Press the “UP key” or “DOWN key” to select desired alert time;

**Step 4:** Press the “OK key” to confirm.

**Note:** If the alarm is ringing and no one answers, then the ring will last for 1 minute; after 3 minutes the ringing will start again.

The alarm will ring for 3 times in total, after this the alarm goes off. Once the alarm is turned on, “ALARM icon” will displayed on the Screen.



## TEMPERATURE UNIT SETTINGS

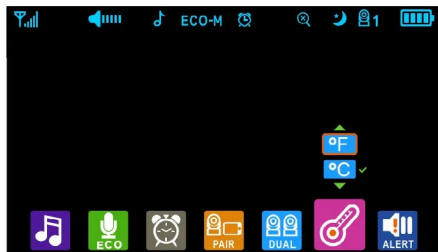
The reading from the temperature sensor will be displayed at the top of the parent unit screen. To change the temperature display from °C to °F, please follow the next instructions:

**Step 1:** Press “MENU/EXIT key” and the menu will display;

**Step 2:** Press the “LEFT key” or “RIGHT key” until the temperature icon is highlighted;

**Step 3:** Press the “UP key” or “DOWN key” to select °C or °F;

**Step 4:** Press the “OK key” to confirm.



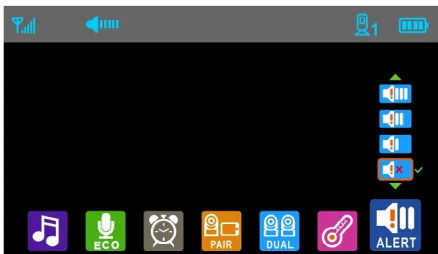
## ALERT VOLUME SETTING

**Step 1:** Press “MENU/EXIT key” and the menu will display;

**Step 2:** Press the “LEFT key” or “RIGHT key” until the ALERT icon is highlighted;

**Step 3:** Press the “UP key” or “DOWN key” to select the desire level;

**Step 4:** Press the “OK key” to confirm.

## 6. TROUBLE SHOOTING

No reception on the monitor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The power adapters may not be properly connected.</li><li>• Check that the camera and monitor are ON.</li><li>• Camera may be far away from the monitor.</li><li>• Camera and monitor may not properly paired, follow PAIRING instructions.</li><li>• Restart baby unit and parent unit.</li><li>• Press the reset key at the back of parent unit.</li></ul>
Interference or poor reception	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Move the monitor close to the camera.</li><li>• The camera or monitor may be placed too close to many metal objects.</li><li>• Other electronic devices may be interfering with the signal.</li><li>• The battery power may be too low.</li><li>• Restart baby unit and parent unit.</li><li>• Press the reset key at the back of parent unit</li></ul>
Feedback (screeching, static)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The camera and monitor may be too close together.</li><li>• The volume on the monitor may be set too high. Press the reset key at the back of parent unit.</li></ul>
Cannot hear the baby on the parent unit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Volume setting may be too low.</li><li>• Press the reset key at the back of parent unit.</li></ul>
Image frozen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Restart the baby unit(plug out the adapter then plug it into the socket again).</li><li>• Press the reset key at the back of parent unit(hide behind the stand).</li></ul>



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
