## EN Collection Glass Baby Bottle

**For your child's safety and health. WARNING. Instructions for use:**

- Remove all parts to clean and sterilize before each use.
- Before first use, place in boiling water for 5 minutes. This is to ensure hygiene. Inspect before each use and pull the feeding teat in all directions. Throw away at the first signs of damage or weakness.
- Sterilize the parts before use.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning materials or chemicals.
- Only use soft bristle brushes or soft sponges. Do not use hard scourers that could scratch the plastic and printing.
- Sterilize through steam sterilization either electric or microwave sterilizers following manufacturer's instructions.
- After sterilizing remove all parts from the sterilizer. Do not leave them inside the sterilizer. Do not leave bottle parts in direct sunlight or heat.
- Do not use pin or sharp object to enlarge the feeding hole.

**Heating instructions:**

- DO NOT pour boiling water into the bottles.
- Remove the protective cap and teat before heating. The bottle must not be sealed when heating or cooling specially inside a microwave or bottle warmer. Stir to distribute heating. Always check food temperature before feeding.

**Warning/Caution:**

- This bottle must always be handled by an adult or under the supervision of an adult.
- Continuous and prolonged sucking of fluids will cause tooth decay.
- Keep all parts out of children reach if not in use. Never use feeding teats as a soother.
- Always inspect the bottle carefully before each use.
- Glass bottles may break.
- Sudden temperature changes can cause glass bottle to crack or break. Make sure the bottle and liquid are at the same temperature when filling or warming.
- Do not use metal tools with the bottle for stirring and cleaning. This can damage the glass on the bottle on the inside or outside. Before each use, inspect the bottle carefully for sharp edges, cracks or glass fragments inside the bottle and parts. Do not use the bottle if there are any sharp edges, cracks or glass fragments in the bottle.
