

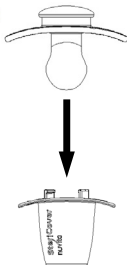

PACIFIER

FOR YOUR CHILD'S SAFETY

WARNING!

- Inspect carefully before each use. Pull the pacifier in all directions. Throw away at the first signs of damage or weakness.
- Only use dedicated pacifier holders tested to EN12586. Never attach ribbons or cords to a pacifier, your child may suffer strangulation.
- Do not leave the product in direct sunlight or near a source of heat, or leave in disinfectant solution for longer than recommended, as this may weaken the pacifier.
- Keep the pacifier cover away from children to avoid suffocation.

CLEANING, STORAGE AND USAGE RECOMMENDATIONS

- Before first use, place the pacifier in boiling water for 5 min, allow to cool, and squeeze out any trapped water from the pacifier. This is to ensure hygiene.
- Clean before every use with mild soap and warm water.
- Do **NOT** use bleach, harsh chemicals or the dishwasher to clean the product.
- Store in a dry place ensuring no water is trapped in the product.
- Never dip the pacifier in sweet substances, as this may cause tooth decay.
- In the event that the product becomes lodged in the mouth, **DO NOT PANIC**; it cannot be swallowed and is designed to cope with such an event. Remove from the mouth with care, as gently as possible.
- For safety and hygiene, replace the product between 1 and 2 months of use.

STERILIZING COVER (ONLY APPLIES TO MODELS WITH STERICOVER)

The Sterilizing cover allows you to sanitize the pacifier in a microwave, killing 99.9% of harmful household germs.

- **Step 1:** Carefully clean the product from any dirt, food or oils.
- **Step 2:** Fill **ONLY** water to the level line on the back of the cover and insert the pacifier.
- **Step 3:** Microwave in upright position following the *timetable. (Incorrect water level, microwave power and time can compromise the sterilization).
- **Step 4:** Allow the product to cool down for few minutes before touching it as it could be very hot.
- **Step 5:** Drain any remaining water.

Save these instructions for future reference.
